

NCAE Kay Trull Award

This **NCAE** award is in memory and honor of Kay Trull, long time member and NCAE advocate from Haywood County. The Kay Trull Outstanding Professional Educator Award is to help NCAE recognize educators who go beyond the call of duty within their school community. Kay was active in the Democratic Party, served as Chair of the NC Professional Standards Commission in the late 1980's early '90s. She was an accomplished teacher and NCAE leader. She was very active in her school community. Any NCAE member is eligible for self nomination or nomination by another NCAE member. The recipient will receive a plaque and a monetary award and have their name added to the perpetual plaque.



Nomination Criteria

1. Active Pre K-12 NCAE educator with a *minimum of 10* years experience.
2. Models best practices and promotes student success.
3. Advocates for a strong school culture by supporting educational research and reform.
4. Understands, responds and influences the larger educational community through political and social involvement.
5. Shows commitment to education as a life-long learner.
6. Extends philosophy of excellence in education beyond the normal work environment

The Application Process: (use 12-pt. font)

1. Complete the attached nomination/data form
2. Provide resume – no more than 2 typed pages
3. Provide two letters of recommendation: typed on school letterhead (can be saved as a PDF)
4. Answer the following questions limiting your responses to one page per question
 - Describe the impact you have (or this educator has) had on the educational community. Include local, regional, state, national or international activities as applicable. What evidence demonstrates that this educator is a well-rounded individual and demonstrates true teacher leadership in the classroom and beyond?
 - What makes this educator outstanding and deserving of this prestigious award/recognition?
